Safety Instructions

These instructions are intended as a guide to the correct use of this equipment. The materials being worked on may require additional safety measures and these must be identified by the user. All users of this tool must be thoroughly acquainted with this manual.

Before Use and Before Using Tool for the First Time

- Make sure you have the relevant Personal Protection Equipment (PPE).

Hand Protection

To minimise the risk of getting fingers trapped in moving parts of this tool, we strongly recommend that you wear gloves.

Eye and Breathing Protection

With tools of this nature, there is always a risk of kicking up dust and other debris. When using this tool we strongly recommend eye and respiratory protection.

Noise and Ear Protection

Noise levels may cause hearing damage including temporary or even permanent hearing loss. It is recommended that Ear Protection is worn at all times when using the this tool.

Repetitive Strain Injury (RSI)

All products of this nature can cause RSI if used for long period, particularly in an awkward operating position. Adequate rest periods and working conditions should be considered for prolonged use.

General Safety Information

- 1 Ensure that all HSE, local authority and general workshop practice regulations are adhered to when using hand tools.
- 2 Use the tool in a well lit area.
- 3 DO NOT hold the workpiece by hand, always make sure the workpiece is clamped securely.
- 4 Keep all flammable and combustible materials away from the work area.
- 5 Children and other unauthorised persons should be kept away from the work area.
- 6 NEVER use this tool whilst the floor underfoot is wet or slippery.
- 7 Keep this tool out of reach of children.
- 8 NEVER use this tool whilst under the influence or drugs, alcohol or intoxicating medication.
- 9 Check you have no loose clothing, hair, jewellery or any items of a personal nature that might become entangled in moving parts.
- 10 Do not use if any part is missing or damaged.
- 11 Misuse of this tool can cause serious injury and death.
- 12 Do not use accessories and attachments that are not designed for use with this product.
- 13 This tool is designed for use with metal, do not use with other materials as unexpected and/or dangerous results may occur.
- 14 Keep the workplace clean and tidy.
- 15 Do not use if there are signs of wear and/or damage.
- 16 Ensure that all threads are clean and lubricated and that all connections are tightly made before commencing work. Keep tools clean and in good condition for best and safest performance. Ensure that the tool is correctly assembled and the correct attachment is used for the job.
- 17 If vehicle is raised for working on, ensure that the axle stands or ramps used are suitable for the task.
- 18 Do not allow heat to be applied to this tool as this will detrimentally affect the strength of the material.
- 19 Do not hit workpiece with a hammer if this tool does not move the dent, consider using a larger capacity puller.
- 20 If possible, cover the rest of the workpiece as appropriate to protect it in the event of a failed part hitting it.

Wise Precaution

When working on a vehicle, always refer to the manual or service instructions to check for hidden wiring, etc behind the work area.
